**Manchester Museum**

On Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2015 the children in Miss Faulkner & Mrs Ashford-Eaton's classes will be visiting the Manchester Museum.

Whilst we are there the children will take part in a 90 minute Egyptian Worlds workshop. This session will provide the children with an opportunity to develop and apply their historical enquiry skills and knowledge of ancient Egypt in the unique setting of the Manchester Museum. Through both object handling and gallery work, pupils will:

Develop their enquiry and investigative skills.

- Interpret evidence from mummy research.
- Solve a 'Raided Tomb Quest' by identifying and reuniting objects that belonged to an ancient Egyptian chantress.

During the visit, the children will also have the opportunity to explore the beautiful range of exhibits including the collection of amphibians and reptiles in the vivarium and they can meet Stan the T.rex.

The coach will leave Mossley at 9.00am prompt (please ensure your child is at school and in their classroom for 8.45am) and will arrive back at school for 4.15pm approx. (parents will be kept informed of the arrival time by text message)

School uniform **does** need to be worn; we are sure they will benefit from this outing, and hope they will have both an interesting and enjoyable day. A packed lunch will be required (**no lunch boxes or bottles - drinks in cartons please**) preferably in a named carrier bag. **Children who usually have a school meal on this day will be provided with a packed lunch from the kitchen and charged unless Mrs Grice is advised otherwise.**
